NARRATIVE:

The Board is being asked to approve a new Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with **Lane Council of Governments (LCOG)** for **Geographic Information System (GIS) services**, under the GIS Cooperative Project Agreement.

Yes

EWEB has used informational system services provided by LCOG for many years. In July 2000, those services were enhanced to include Geographic Information System services through an annual Geographic Information System Cooperative Project Agreement (GIS CPA). EWEB entered into this IGA with Lane Council of Governments beginning July 1, 2000 pursuant to ORS 190.010. Under this agreement, LCOG provides GIS Services, which allows EWEB access to the Regional Land Information Database (RLID).

Annual fees are paid to LCOG for these services by the regional partner agencies (EWEB, LCOG, Cities of Eugene and Springfield, and Lane County). EWEB's share of this year's fee is \$76,000.
